

How to make an unlined Skjoldehamn hood

Materials needed

- ½ yard of 100% wool or linen
- thread – polyester is fine
- sewing machine or hand sewing needle
- Depending upon sewing experience, this hood will take from 15 minutes to a couple of hours.

Prewash fabric – yes really!

- Wool – wash in cold water, hang to dry
- Linen – wash in hot water, machine dry on high

Cutting it out

- Cut 2 pieces 12' X 12'' – these will be the front and back of the hood
- Cut two pieces 13'' X 26.5'' OR one piece 13'' X 52''
 - These sizes already include a ½'' seam allowance on all pieces.

Sewing it together

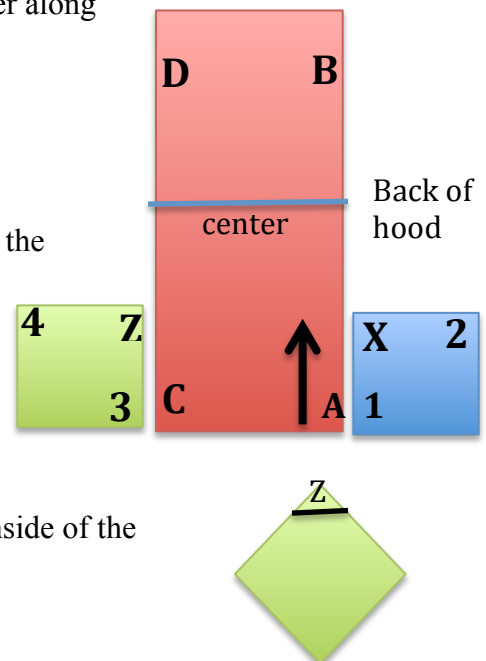
If you are using 2 pieces for the long piece, sew them together along the top edge using ½'' seam allowance.

Back of hood

1. Sew corner A to corner 1, sew up to corner X
2. Sew corner B to corner 2, sew up to X
3. Continue seam all the way up the back of the hood to the center top.

Front of hood

1. Sew corner C to corner 3 – leave ½'' unsewn at top of square (Z)
2. Fold the ½'' down forming a triangle (Z) facing the inside of the hood – sew seam C/3 up to top of folded triangle
3. Sew corner D to corner 4 sew up to top of fold, (Z)



Finishing up

Finish your hood with a 1/2'' inch seam at hem and around the face. You might choose to finish your seams with a decorative stitch.
