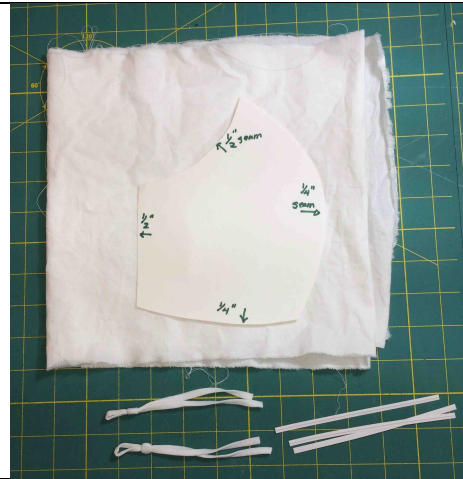


Making a mask




Needed Materials

- 24" X 8" of 100% cotton, prewashed
- mask pattern
- thread
- ear elastic
- 3 paper covered wire ties
- Sewing machine



Putting it together:

<p>1. Printout and cut out pattern from PDF</p>	
<p>2. Cut out 4 mask pieces (2 of fashion fabric, 2 of lining fabric)</p>	
<p>3. Sew front edges of fashion fabric and lining fabric</p>	
<p>4. Sew lining and outside fabric, right sides together along top. Use 1/2" seam allowance</p>	
<p>5. Sew on nose wires on 1/2" seam allowance, use a zigzag stitch to secure them</p>	
<p>6. Add first ear elastic, sew seam</p>	
<p>7. Turn mask right side out</p>	
<p>8. Add top stitch along nose wire</p>	

<p>making a casing area for the wire</p>
